The approval of the COB shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. All expenditures, whether for current operating expenditures or COs, shall be made within the limits of available funds realized from corporate receipts, authorized corporate borrowings and National Government budgetary support either in the form of subsidy, equity or loans outlay.

- 2. Disbursement for personnel allowances/benefits shall be subject to the pertinent compensation laws, rules and regulations, including E.O. Nos. 7 and 24 dated September 8, 2010 and February 10, 2011, respectively. Such expenditures shall also be conditioned on the relevant General Provisions of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10717, the FY 2016 General Appropriations Act (ex. Representation and Transportation Allowance under Section 59, General Provisions), or any specific law or approval of the President of the Philippines or Secretary of Budget and Management, as the case maybe.
- 3. Disbursements for Extraordinary and Miscellaneous Expenses shall be subject to Section 47, General Provisions of R.A. No. 10717.
- 4. For equipment items per Annual Equipment Procurement Program that require specific clearance/approval from the Agencies concerned (ex. Information and Communications Technology Office (DICT-ICT Office) for information technology equipment), the same shall be secured before acquisition thereof in accordance with Corporate Budget Circular No. 17 dated February 9, 1996.
- 5. The fiscal discipline measures prescribed under A.O. No. 103 dated August 31, 2004 shall be observed.
- 6. It is understood that this approval does not authorize any item of expenditure that is prohibited by or inconsistent with the provisions of law.
- 7. The pertinent laws, rules and regulations including those on compensation, procurement, budgeting, accounting and auditing shall be strictly followed. Compliance with all existing laws, rules and regulations shall be the responsibility of the implementing government corporation.
