











Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) PLANS using CBMS data.



























CBMS data are also proven to be useful in post-calamity intervention

 - Easily locate households who accepts evacuees from the taal eruption
 - Easily identify households affected by the taal eruption within the municipality
 - Verify the names and identity of those who are suspicious individual in jurisdiction for safety and security purposes
