The celebration serves as a platform to promote and draw nationwide awareness of the importance of policy research in nation building.

This year's theme, "Navigating the New Globalization: Local Actions for Global Challenges" or in Filipino "Paglayag sa Bagong Globalisasyon: Lokal na Pagkilos sa mga Pandaigdigang Hamon", aims to enlighten stakeholders on the various challenges that come along with globalization, notably the issues of rising protectionism, worsening inequality trends, worldwide economic restructuring, widening polarization, and proliferation of disinformation.
