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

The 2019 mid-year total external trade in goods amounted to \$86.9 billion reflected a slight decrease of 0.5% from the \$87.4 billion external trade in the same period of the previous year.








### **PH Trade Situation**










### PH Top Export Markets: Jan-Jun 2019















### **Top 3 Trade Partners**

From 2014 to 2018, exports to Japan has decreased by 25.7%; exports to US increased by 23%; and exports to China increased by 4.12%.








## MSMEs in exports and sectors
