


Budget and Treasury Management System (BTMS)




BUDGET AND TREASURY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (BTMS)



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








Total Covered Percentage of Expenditures from FY 2020 GAA



BTMS

From 2018 to 2019, the BTMS covered 12 agencies capturing 30.98% of total expenditures for FY 2020.

For 2020, the BTMS targets to bring on board an additional 23 agencies capturing 50.53% of total expenditures.




FY 2021 Medium-Term Information and Communications Technology Harmonization Initiative (MITHI) Expenditures
