The PCF was allocated with **500 Million Pesos** under the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2011

2019

The **SGLG** and **PCF** are institutionalized under **SGLG ACT/RA 11292**

The **SGLG/PCF** has continued to evolve

2012 - 2018
