



#### Data governance for children

Featured project | Developing a manifesto to protect children's data security and privacy

The fluidity of children's attitudes, preferences and identity, along with the lower capacity of younger children to make informed decisions and have full agency presents unique challenges to children's data security and privacy.

This raises issues beyond data protection including: the validity of applying concepts such as informed consent to children; the extent to which parents can serve as surrogates for decisions regarding children's data; and the right to have data erased or forgotten. There is widespread belief that standards of data protection and security concerning children should be set at a higher level.

Data governance concerns the universe of rules and norms under which data use falls. Beyond data management or even data protection, it entails policy, strategies, standards, rights and accountability on the end-to-end cycle of data. However, currently there is no global set of standards on children's data governance that addresses key concerns related

#### From Space to Supply Chains: A Plan for Humanitarian Data Governance

#### <u>Abstract</u>

In June of 2019, the World Food Programme (WFP) issued an ultimatum to the Houthi Government in Yemen: participate in our biometric identification system or receive less aid. The Houthis chose to a partial stoppage of aid, accusing the WFP of being a surveillance operation. The issue is complicated – on both sides – but it points to a significantly larger trend: humanitarian organizations' digital operations and data sharing relationships increasingly shape whether beneficiaries, governments, and partners trust them. And, for humanitarian organizations, trust determines their license to operate, which is often negotiated with a range of parties in difficult contexts. At a practical level, humanitarian organizations digital transformations aren't just changing response efforts – they're also changing the role of humanitarian organizations themselves, from direct service providers to managing a network of digital vendors, public/private partnerships, local partners, and governments – and all of their competing interests in the data response efforts produce.



## Conclusions + Recommendations

- Public technologies in implementation is political
- We need clear infrastructures for public testing
- Legal and contractual guard rails should be pre-deployment requirements – including pathways to dispute + wind-down
- Important to create quality assurance layers beyond functionality, anticipating application in law enforcement contexts
- Define harms based on impact, not procedure
- Invest in research oversight and public communication
