Policy Questions and Objectives

Scope, Data and Methodology

- Mixed methods approach, sequential parallel analysis and process evaluation, desk review, KIIs and HGDs, and case studies....
- Are relevant methodologies
- Clarifying question however is:
 - How are SDG indicators embedded in the set of indicators identified in the PDP?



Hard Facts As Shown in the Study

- Almost 95% of the respondent LGUs, 74 out of 76 provinces, and 16 out of 17 NCR LGUs have responded and submitted their RMs;
- Almost complete compliance with Executive Order No. 27, Series of 2017 and DILG Memorandum dated 29 August 2019 on PDP and SDG localization
- Of the 16 regions, while 82% of the indicators with baselines, only 67% had indicators with targets. It could be surmised that many regions failed to set their SDG and PDP targets
- The regional summaries shows a clear depiction of localization of PDP and SDG



Citing Iloilo's RMs

- Out of 431 reported indicators, only 13.50% is aligned with SDGs, 52% with baseline data and only 45.70% of the indicators are with targets.
- Almost half of the reported indicators do not have baseline data (48%) and annual targets (54.3%).
- With such data, SDG and PDP localization could not be determined and ascertained



Case Studies

- Case studies provided an important insight into the performance of each LGU in terms of PDP and SDG localization. This is an important component in monitoring the progress of the localization efforts.
- Performance of each LGU and Region shall have to be analyzed in order to determine appropriate recommendations to further improve the localization process



KII results and General Findings

- Undoubtedly, KII results showed that Result Matrices are important tools in monitoring the progress of localization.
- Lack of manpower, lack of technical capacity, poor coordination are just few of the concerns in making localization process effective and relevant to the LGUs
- The process of institutionalization of the localization process is also relevant though PDP targets changes and varies in every change of Philippine Government Administration.



Specific Recommendations

- Amend DILG, DBM, NEDA and DOF JMC No. 1 Series of 2016 dated November 18, 2016 on the "Updated Guidelines on the Harmonization of Local Planning, Investment Programming, Resource Mobilization, Budgeting, Expenditure Management, and Performance Monitoring and Coordination in Fiscal Oversight" to include PDP and SDG localization tools in Monitoring and Coordination
- Clearly stipulate that the Local Planning & Development Office shall spearhead the localization efforts by virtue of its functions as per Section 476 of the LGC of 1991
- Incorporate PDP And SDG localization as one of the performance indicators in compliance with SGLG
- Continuous capacity and technical assistance shall be provided by the oversight agencies to the LGUs
