TERMS OF REFERENCE <u>Data Manager and Quality Assurance Officer - Hospital Quality</u>

for

PIDS-DOH Project on Development of Integrated Service Delivery / Public Health Programs Monitoring and Evaluation Framework and Application of Analysis in Relevant Quantitative Data

1. Background and Rationale

In 2021, PIDS conducted a study that aimed to measure whether Philippine hospitals have the necessary foundational structures and inputs in place to provide high quality health care services. Results of this study may point out gaps or opportunities for improvement to health providers, provide a baseline on the service capability and readiness of hospitals, and give insight to DOH and PhilHealth on how to improve their continuous quality improvement programs for health facilities. Due to limited time and resources, not all the hospitals were able to submit hospital profile and quality data. In 2024, the collection and analysis of the remaining hospital profile and quality data will resume to update the current analyses on the service capability of hospitals to provide high quality health care. As such, there is a need to hire a data manager and quality assurance officer to facilitate the collection, cleaning, processing, and validation of hospital profile and quality data from hospitals.

2. Objectives

The general objective of the study is to evaluate whether Philippine hospitals have the necessary structures and inputs that facilitate high quality health care services. Specifically, the study aims to describe the service capability and readiness of Philippine hospitals to provide general health services.

3. Objectives of the Consultancy

The project is seeking to hire a **Data Manager and Quality Assurance Officer for Hospital Quality (Consultant)** for the nationwide data collection and pre-processing of hospital quality data.

4. Scope of Work, Deliverables and Schedule of Payment Releases

Under the guidance and technical oversight of a PIDS Research Fellow who serves as the Project Director, the Data Manager and Quality Assurance Officer for Hospital Quality (Consultant)¹ is expected to work with the PIDS Project Team and undertake the following tasks/activities²

- 1. Assist the PIDS study team in the nationwide data collection of hospital responses in the DOH hospital quality data collection tool (minimum of 600 hospitals for hospital quality)
- 2. Coordinate with the hospital data coordinators (using virtual means e.g., online meetings and communication) regarding the data collection of hospital quality data collection tool (prepared by PIDS in-house study team).
- 3. Monitor hospital submissions, troubleshoot problems, and answer questions of hospital respondents regarding the data being collected
- 4. Call and coordinate with each of the hospitals regarding the submissions and validate each data field for correctness and accuracy
- 5. Perform data necessary data transformation and pre-processing to prepare datasets for analysis
- 6. Curate and compile codebook and metadata for each of the dataset
- 7. Sign a Non-Disclosure Undertaking with PIDS. Any information gathered and generated in the implementation of the project shall be processed subject to the applicable provisions of the Republic Act No. 10173, known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and relevant issuances of the National Privacy Commission (NPC).
- 8. Others as may be assigned by the Project Director.

5. Qualifications of the Consultant

- c) Advanced skills in the management of databases, data quality checks, initial data processing, project management, and communication

6. Project Duration

The engagement will commence upon the signing of the contract until December 31, 2024, on a part-time basis. The Consultant's work must be completed within this period, and no mandays will be chargeable after this date.

7. Project Cost

The estimated cost of this consulting service is PHP 160,000.00. This amount does not include travel and accommodation during fieldwork. PIDS will shoulder the cost of fieldwork. PIDS shall not cover hospitalization and other COVID-related health expenses of the consultant as no employer-employee relationship exists between the PIDS and the Consultant.
