TERMS OF REFERENCE

One Layout Artist for PIDS Publications

1. Background and Objective

The Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS) conducts policy-oriented studies to assist policymakers and decisionmakers in crafting evidence-informed plans, policies, and programs. These are disseminated through different types of publications, such as Books, Research Paper Series, Philippine Journal of Development, Development Research News, Policy Notes, Economic Policy Monitor, Annual Public Policy Conference proceedings, and Annual Report.

The Institute upholds a quality policy in the conduct and dissemination of its research studies. It, therefore, seeks to engage the services of a **Layout Artist** to ensure the quality of its publications and their timely release.

2. Scope of Work, Deliverables, and Schedule of Payment Release/s

Under the technical oversight of the Director/Manager of the PIDS Research Information Department, assisted by the Division Chief of the Publications and Circulation Division, the Layout Artist is expected to do the following:

- 1) Layout the manuscript (text, figures, tables, images) using Adobe InDesign and other appropriate software following the template of the PIDS publication;
- 2) Proofread and enter corrections;
- 3) Submit the electronic files of the final laid-out pages (both in Adobe InDesign and Adobe PDF) ready for uploading and printing;
- 4) Submit three cover designs for each PIDS book; and
- 5) Incorporate the comments of PIDS on the selected cover and submit the final cover (both in Adobe Photoshop/Illustrator and Adobe PDF).

Note: At least two galley proofs (and a third one as the need arises) shall be produced by the Layout Artist for PIDS' approval prior to finalization. The final output must include all the linked files.

In addition, he/she must submit three cover designs for each PIDS book and the final covers.

Deliverables and schedule of payment release

The Layout Artist is expected to submit the outputs within the timeline set by PIDS. Payment shall be PHP **150/page**. The total fee will depend on the final number of pages laid out. The publication size is 6" x 9".

Around 15 manuscripts shall be laid out with texts, tables, figures, and images. There will be additional pages for the preliminaries and back matters.

3. Project Cost

The project costs approximately **PHP 70,000**, covering around 15 manuscripts, including the cost of cover design at PhP6,000 per completed cover. The payment for the page layout shall be per page of the laid-out manuscript at PhP150 per page. Any increase/decrease in the total number of laid-out pages shall be charged/deducted accordingly at PhP150.00 per page.

Payment can be made after the submission of each final output/laid out pages and their acceptance and approval by PIDS.

4. Project Duration

The engagement is from May 1, 2025 to April 30, 2026 from the issuance of the notice to proceed.

5. Qualifications of the Consultant and Evaluation Criteria:

Below are the required qualifications of the Layout Artist and the evaluation criteria:

a.	Associate or Bachelor's degree (preferably in graphic design,	30%
	communication arts, and other related discipline);	
b.	Strong layouting skills and experience of at least five (5) years; and	40%
c.	Extensive knowledge and background in layouting publications,	
	especially policy-oriented and data-intensive studies.	30%

6. Ownership of Data

All information, data, reports, or any other material, graphic software, or otherwise prepared, collected, and gathered by the Layout Artist under the project's duration shall belong to and remain the exclusive property of PIDS. Said materials should be properly documented and turned over to the Institute before the end of the engagement. The Contractor shall not use in any manner the information and data gathered for commercial or other purposes, and such information and data shall be for the exclusive use of PIDS.

7. Compliance with PIDS Data Privacy Policy

Before the commencement of work for this specific project, the Layout Artists shall be asked to sign a nondisclosure agreement with PIDS. Any information gathered and generated in the implementation of the project shall be processed subject to the applicable provisions of the Republic Act 10173, known as the "Data Privacy Act of 2012" and its Implementing Rules and Regulations and relevant issuances of the National Privacy Commission (NPC).
