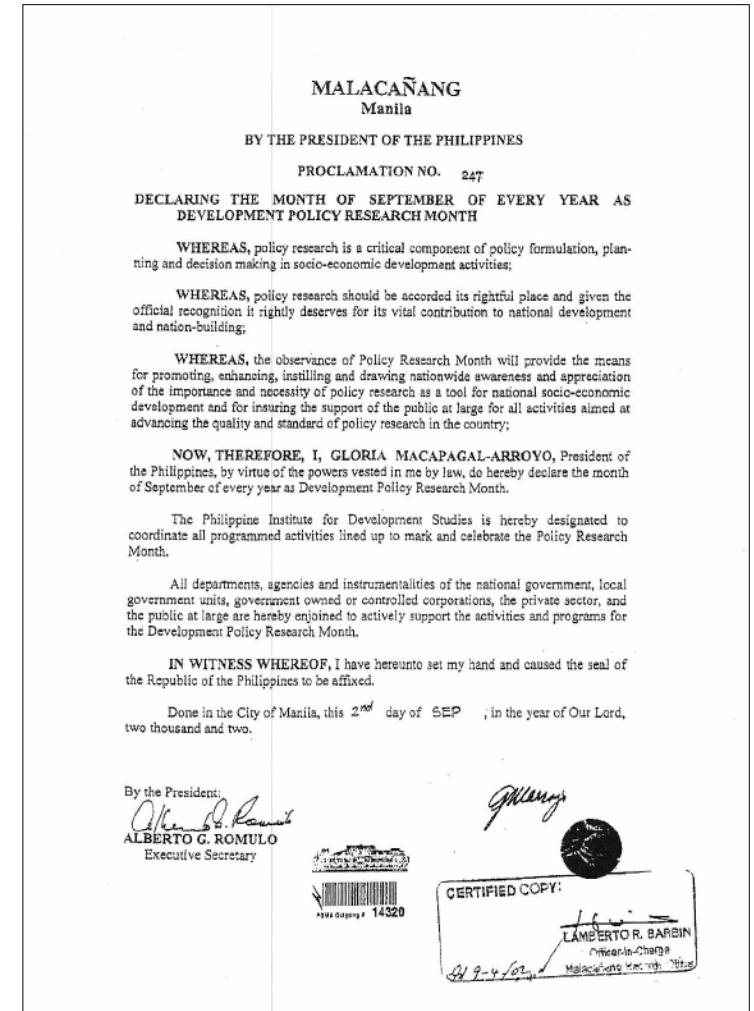

BIRTH OF THE DPRM

- In September 2002, as recommended by members of the research community, Malacañang issued Proclamation No. 247.
- The Proclamation calls for the observance of the Development Policy Research Month (DPRM) every year in September.
- Designates the PIDS as the convenor/coordinator of the yearly celebration.



BIRTH OF THE DPRM

Promote, enhance, instill, and draw nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance of policy research in national development planning and policymaking

Cultivate a strong culture of research and research use among decisionmakers and the general public, and improve the public's research and information literacy of socioeconomic issues

Elicit public support for activities that are meant to advance the standard of policy research in the country

Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 247, s. 2002, the **Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS)** will lead the annual **Development Policy Research Month (DPRM)** celebration in **September**. The celebration serves as a platform to promote and draw nationwide awareness of the importance of policy research in the formulation of national development plans, programs and policies.

This year's theme, **"CloseTheGap: Accelerate Post-pandemic Recovery through Social Justice"** or in Filipino **"AlisinAngAgwat: Pabilisin ang Pag-ahon Mula sa Pandemya sa Pamamagitan ng Katarungang Panlipunan"**, aims to highlight how the pandemic exacerbated existing socioeconomic disparities in the country and disproportionately affected the vulnerable and marginalized sectors of society. Hence, to make opportunities equitable, reduce socioeconomic and political inequalities, and remove cultural inequities, it is crucial to make social justice a guiding principle of the country's post-pandemic recovery plan, particularly in the areas of human capital development and social protection, public health services and infrastructure, and environmental resilience.

To promote public awareness in the observance of the event, all government agencies are encouraged to undertake the following activities/initiatives:

How we conduct the DPRM

- We encourage **government agencies, academic and research institutions (both public and private), LGUs, the private sector, civil society, and international organizations** to participate in the DPRM by sending them an invitation letter with details on how they can participate.

How to participate in the DPRM

- By featuring the DPRM in official publication(s), website, and social media pages
- By organizing activities or events (e.g., seminars, policy dialogues) related to the theme or to policy research
- By resharing social media posts about the DPRM and its activities

How to participate in the DPRM

- By displaying the physical DPRM banner in the office premises or the e-banner on the official website and social media pages.



DPRM Activities

- We herald the start of the DPRM by holding a **press conference** or a **kick-off forum**. We also hold press conferences outside of Metro Manila with the help of the Philippine Information Agency. These are in-person events but **starting 2020, we hold the kick-off forum online.**

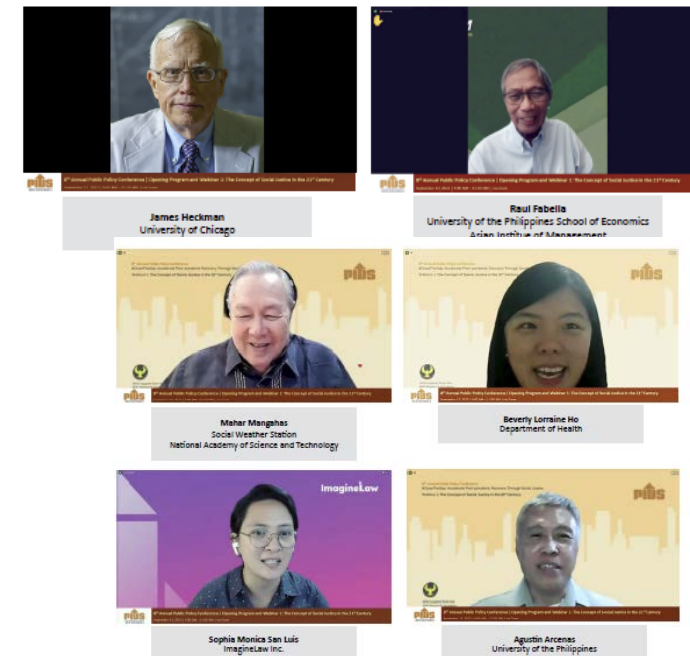


DPRM Activities

- Since 2015, PIDS has been organizing the **Annual Public Policy Conference (APPC)** which aims to flag to policymakers current and emerging policy issues. The APPC serves as the main and culminating activity of the DPRM.

DPRM Activities

During the APPC (prepandemic), we hold a **publications exhibit** with the DPRM steering committee partner- institutions and APPC sponsors as exhibitors. We intend to revive the exhibit this year.



DPRM Activities

- Since 2015, PIDS and the Mindanao Development Authority (MinDA) have been co-organizing the Mindanao Policy Research Forum with a partner university.



DPRM Activities

- In coordination with media networks, PIDS officials and research fellows **guest in radio and television shows** to discuss the importance of policy research, explain the DPRM theme, and promote the APPC.



DPRM Activities

- We **use social media** (Facebook and Twitter) to promote the DPRM and its activities. The DPRM Steering Committee partner-institutions and participating agencies help by resharing the posts in their social media platforms or producing related content.

DPRM Activities

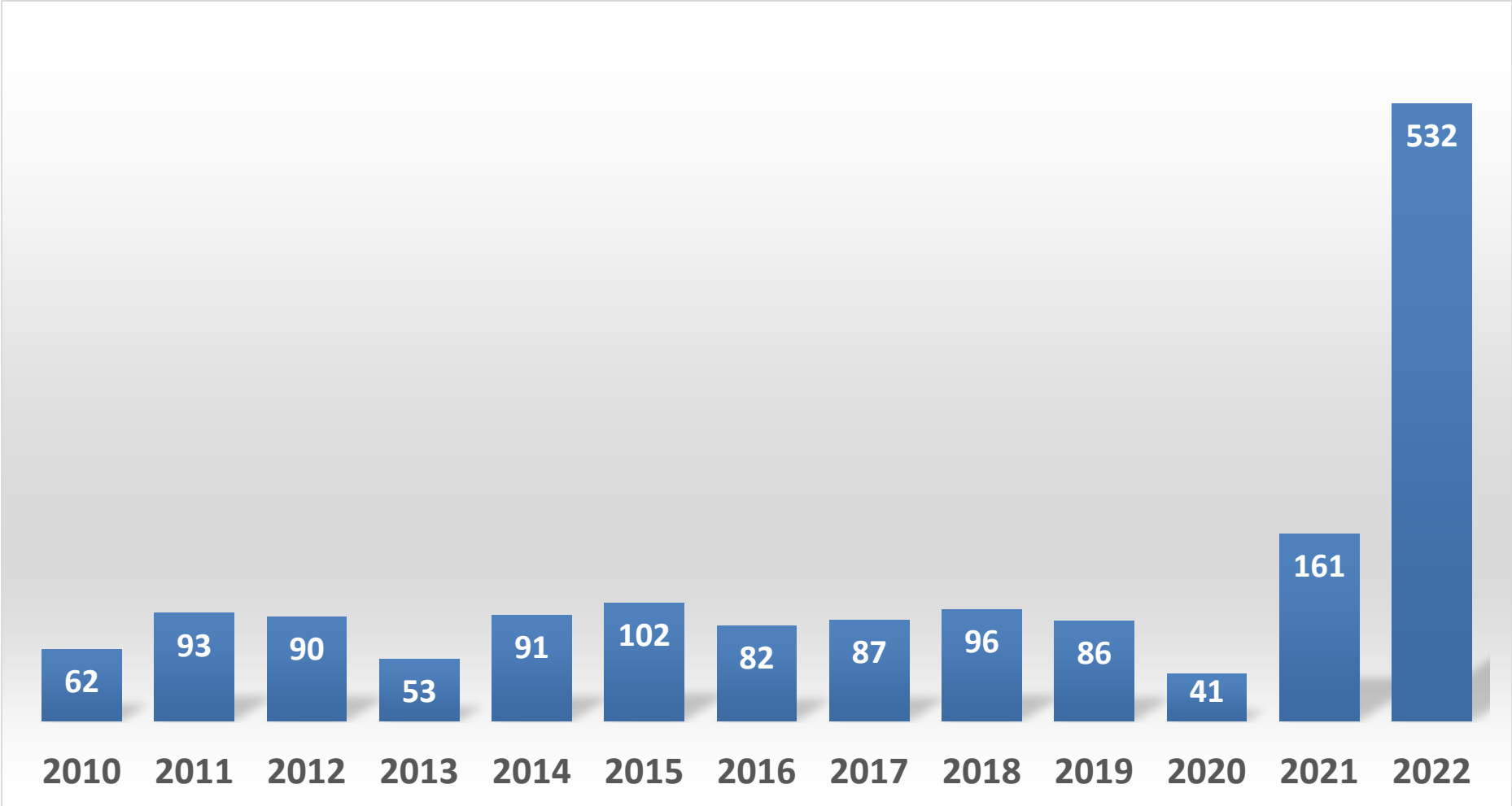
- In 2020, 2021, and 2022, given the limitations posed by the pandemic, all the DPRM activities were conducted virtually.
