Economic

Highlight the participation of the residents in the informal economy to make ends meet. These spaces debunk the notion that urban poor are lazy, dependent, and useless.

Institutional

Manifest the aspirations and efforts of the residents to establish a sense of place despite the continuous state abandonment and the lack of access to basic social services.

Longing

Invoke a feeling of nostalgia through the memories of the residents as they remember the past. Serves as a reminder of how far they've come to struggle for urban housing justice.

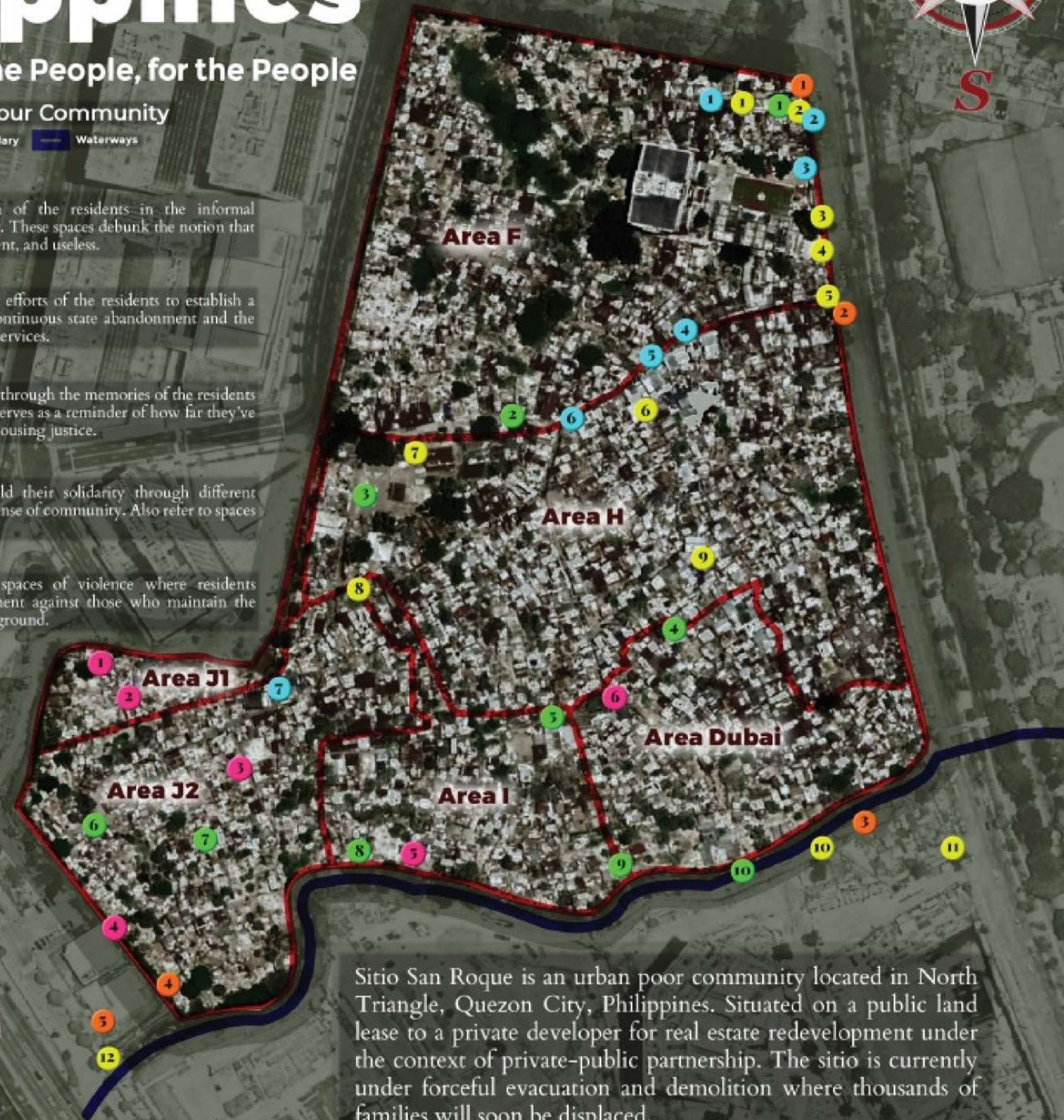
Recreational

Spaces where residents build their solidarity through different activities that nurture their sense of community. Also refer to spaces of gatherings and leisure.

Terror

Represent the threat and spaces of violence where residents associate anger and resentment against those who maintain the unequal power relations on ground.

Sitio San Roque is an urban poor community located in North Triangle, Quezon City, Philippines. Situated on a public land lease to a private developer for real estate redevelopment under the context of private-public partnership. The sitio is currently under forceful evacuation and demolition where thousands of families will soon be displaced.

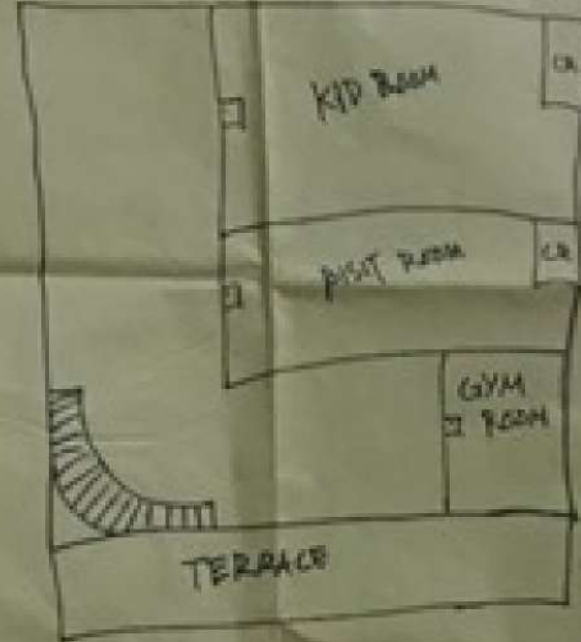
