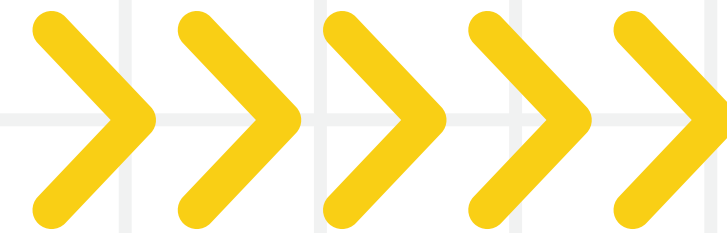


DOE is implementing short-term measures to address power supply issues which include the following:




STUDY 1

DOE, in partnership with other government agencies, is facilitating the development of renewable energy sources. Combined with the necessary transmission development, RE sources can secure long-term power supply for the Philippines.
