





CBS will decrease administrative burden and increase implementation capacity of agencies




Stacking Up of Projects due to Delayed Implementation results to unrealized socioeconomic targets



Obligation and Disbursement Tend Upward Despite Headwinds








Optimizing eGovernance

Implementation of Cash Budgeting System; Strengthening oversight of Bureau of the Treasury on government bank accounts; Deployment of Integrated Financial Management Information System;

Oversight Internal Audit Standards; and Institutionalization of public participation in budget process

Digital Payments for Government Disbursements:


- Payment of goods and services


